Over the years, we've heard the eclectic Sister Dorothy play everything from pop to jazz to reggae to classical to Christmas carols. But for this eighth release, she comes up with something we've never heard before: A disc of traditional Mennonite folk music sung entirely in German and accompanied by acoustic guitar and flute. Surprisingly, Kernlieder – which translates as "core songs" - turns out to be more accessible than you'd think, thanks to Dot's sweet vocals and relaxing approach.
